Foundational Courses (CSD 207, 208 and 209) must be completed with a C or better to progress to the upper level CSD coursework.

* A biology and physics/chemistry course is required for the CSD major. These courses may be taken as part of General Education, as part of the BS requirement, or as a non-departmental required course. However, a course cannot double count for both General Education and Bachelor Degree requirements (all Bachelor Degree requirements are in addition to what was taken to fulfill General Education).

Please note that 400 level courses can only be taken by seniors, 300 level courses by juniors & seniors, and 200 level courses by sophomores, juniors, and seniors. Finally, permission to repeat/forgive a CSD course will only be given after those who have not taken the course have registered. Students hoping to obtain permission to repeat/forgive or take a course out of sequence should check with the CSD departmental office staff on how to obtain permission.
