*A biology and a physics/chemistry course are required for the CSD major. These courses may be taken as part of General Education, as part of the BS requirement, or as a non-departmental required course. Remember, a course cannot double count for both General Education and Bachelor Degree requirements.

Repeating a CSD course is contingent on course capacity. Repeat is only allowed after all students who have not taken the course for the first time have registered. CSD200 also requires special permission to repeat.
